a) Upper age limits:

1. Not exceeding 45 years for Project Assistants as on the date of interview.
2. Not exceeding 40 years for Workshop attendant as on the date of interview.
3. Age relaxation for SC/ST candidates 05 years and OBC candidates 03 years as per Government of India instructions.

b) Mode of Selection: Through walk- in Interview.

1. At the time of interview candidates should bring on latest photograph, attested copies of certificates of examination passed (starting from matriculation), certificate indicating date of birth, caste certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC) and experience certificate etc.
2. Tentative mark sheets/certificates and 'result awaited' will not be considered
3. All eligible candidates are requested to be present at the venue on the said date 01 hour before the scheduled time (10.30 am) for necessary formalities.
4. However, if large numbers of candidates turn up, a screening test comprising of multiple choice objective questions and/or practical will be held for short listing the candidates for interview.
5. The short listed candidates will be interviewed by the selection committee and based on the performance in the interview a panel of recommended candidates will be formed.
6. Selection to the position will not entitle the candidate to any future positions at MGIRI (Permanent or Otherwise). As with all project positions at MGIRI, the positions are purely temporary on contract basis and co-terminus with the sponsored projects.
7. The appointments on these positions will be purely temporary and will be terminable at one month's notice on either side.
8. Further the above salary/ wages is tentative and the same will be finally decided based on the availability of funds in the relevant sponsored projects.
9. To avoid any inconvenience, only those candidates who strictly fulfill the eligibility criteria and possess the degree/mark sheet in the aforesaid subjects should turn up for floating interview.
